It is our pleasure to invite you to the Fourth Interdisciplinary Accounting Conference in Copenhagen on June 14th and 15th, 2010. The conference will bring together researchers who draw on academic research in the fields of accounting, finance, and microeconomics. The theme of the conference is the role of accounting as a carrier of information to parties within and outside the firm.

- Accounting is mobilized in the valuation of common equity and, thus, accounting and its regulation have implications for the functioning of capital markets.
- Accounting is used in the control of financial institutions and, thus, it follows that accounting and its uses in regulation have an impact on the financial sector in times of crisis.
- Accounting outcomes serve as an indicator of individual as well as organizational performance and, thus, accounting is often used in assessing the effects of different corporate governance structures.
- Accounting plays both decision-facilitating and decision-influencing roles within organizations. In its decision-facilitating role, accounting influences production decisions and competitive responses and in its decision-influencing role, the anticipated accounting consequences serve to influence individual behavior. Thus, accounting and its regulation have implications for labor as well as product markets.

Performance evaluation of individuals and business units
The role of accounting in decision making
Cost of capital and financial disclosure
